SUGGESTED MATERIALS

- A rock, not a smooth one!
- 6 sheets of quality, thick art paper (cartridge paper okay and at least 1 heavier weight paper such as watercolour paper for the final task)
- Compressed charcoal (2 sticks)
- A hard eraser, not a kneadable one
- Warm white or neutral tone chalk pastel
- Burnt sienna ink or substitute with coffee/red wine
- A few containers, one with water
- stick or something stick like...ruler, wooden spoon, 30-40cm approx
- Paper towel
- Masking tape
- 3 - 5 reference images of landscapes or something else of interest to you

BEFORE THE WORKSHOP

Prepare a sheet of paper ahead of the workshop so the sheet is dry and ready to use.

Instructions:

- Dip paper towel or a large brush into black coffee or diluted ink (about half or less than its saturated strength).
- Wipe over your paper to create a surface to draw on; it doesn't have to be painted 'nice' or good or completely all over, it's just a preliminary layer to draw on.
